Meeting Called to Order by Sophia Meyer at 6:03pm.

Roll Call: Sophia Meyer, Steve Langley, Leslie Nemeth, Steve Schaffer, Cathy Ivazes, Sandi Bownas, Dan Vielhauer.

New Business: Sharon Hines has volunteered to become our new bookkeeper and has met with Hosea and Sophia who highly recommend her.
